ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION -MONDAY - APRIL 9, 2018

Nomination papers for elected offices are available from the Town Clerk for the 2018 Election of Officers beginning January 2, 2018 during regular office hours –

Monday - 8:30 am to 4:00 pm and 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm
Tuesday & Wednesday - 8:30 am to 12:00 pm

or by appointment.

Last day to obtain and submit nomination papers to the Board of Registrars for certification –Tuesday, February 20, 2018, by 5:00 pm.

Last day to file nomination papers with the Town Clerk –Monday, March 5, 2018 by 5:00 pm.

Last day to object or withdraw nomination papers – Wednesday, March 7, 2018 by 5:00 pm.

Last day to register voters for the Annual Town Election –Tuesday, March 20, 2018 by 8:00 pm

VOTER REGISTRATION SESSION AS FOLLOWS -

Municipal Building, 307 Main St., Gilbertville – Tuesday, March 20, 2018 from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm. This is the last day and hour to register voters who wish to vote at the Annual Town Election. Mail in Voter Registration Forms will be accepted if postmarked on or before the March 20, 2018 deadline.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS -

Financial Statements must be filed by ALL CANDIDATES for election by the following dates, even if the candidate has no financial activity to report and also if the candidate loses the election.

8th day prior to election – Report -#1 – shall be filed with the Town Clerk by Monday, April 2, 2018 by 4:00 pm. This report shall cover the financial activity reporting period beginning January 1, 2018 thru March 22, 2018.

30th day following the election - Report #2 - shall be filed with the Town Clerk by Wednesday, May 9, 2018 by 4:00 pm. This report covers the financial activity reporting period beginning March 23, 2018 thru April 30, 2018.
