

**Commonwealth of Massachusetts
Town of Hardwick
Warrant for Special Town Meeting**

To the Town Clerk and Constables, Town of Hardwick

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Hardwick, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Hardwick Elementary School, 531 Lower Road, Gilbertville, Massachusetts on Saturday, June 16, 2007 at 1:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles:

<p>Note: Funds acquired through borrowing require a 2/3 vote. Note: Funds acquired through raise and appropriate (taxation) and transferring require a majority vote Note: Transfers in and out of Stabilization require a 2/3 vote. Note: Zoning Bylaws and Amendments require a 2/3 vote. Note: General Bylaws and Amendments require a majority vote. Note: Prior year/Unprovided for accounts require a 9/10 vote.</p>

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow, or transfer from available funds in the treasury, a sum of money to provide for a 5% grant match as required under the FY 2007 FEMA assistance to Firefighters Grant, or take any other action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Fire Department

Article 2. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to the Paige Memorial Library Salary Account (#01-610-5110), or take any other action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Paige Memorial Library Trustees

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or otherwise fund a sum of money to be used in conjunction with, and in addition to, any funds allotted by the Commonwealth for the construction, and/or improvement of town roads, as requested by the Board of Selectmen, in their discretion, to be returned to the Treasury when reimbursed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, or take any other action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Highway Surveyor

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Recycling Repairs and Replacement Account (#01-475-5820) to Recycling Expense Account (01-475-5700-00) to cover unexpected expenses from PAYT planning and advertising, tires from the elementary school and electronics from the Youth Center.

Sponsor: Recycling Commission

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to meet overdrawn and unprovided for accounts in the current fiscal year 2007, or take any other action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Board of Selectmen

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to meet overdrawn and unprovided for accounts in the fiscal year 2006, or take any other action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Board of Selectmen

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the following accounts to the Stabilization Account:

- Dispatch Reserve Account
- Fire Equipment Account
- Fire Station Addition Account
- Highway Equipment Account
- Gilbertville WPCF Equipment
- Wheelwright WPCF Equipment
- Unemployment Account

Or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in each of the Post Offices in said Hardwick, fourteen days at least before the time of said meeting. Hereof and fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk on or before the time of said meeting.
