Additional items that should be addressed prior to Annual CMR 780 Table 110 Inspection.

- \_\_\_\_\_ All exit signs and emergency lights shall be tested to verify they are in good working order. Any malfunctioning devices must be repaired immediately.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Oil fired appliances are to be inspected, cleaned and tagged annually.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Current inspection of elevators. Note: All testing must be completed in accordance with applicable State Building Code and NFPA standards
