

## Town Administrator Report, June 26, 2023

- USDA.
  - Equipment for project 2 has been awarded to Aqua Aerobic Systems.
  - Wheelwright Wastewater Treatment Plant should be going out to bid in the next couple of weeks. Debt repayment is still being discussed.
  - Oversight RFP's have been sent to the Board for their perusal. I've contacted Whitewater Wastewater to see if they do it as well. Waiting to hear back.

### *New:*

- We lost Laurie Dell'Ollio as Accountant. A new Accountant will be assigned to us soon. We should explore a shared accountant with another town.
- Our streaming equipment has been on the fritz for some time. The company we purchased it from sold to a west coast company and we have been having communication issues. We hope to have this resolved very soon.
- We submitted testimony for Hardwick at the statehouse on Thursday, June 22 to equalize the values for PILOT's and state owned land in the commonwealth
- I received a quote for new electric vehicle charging stations. It is approximately \$40,000.00. Out of pocket expense will be around \$5,000.00

### *Ongoing:*

- Town Hall boiler update. The flooring is nearly complete. I am hoping it's all finished by June 30. The finance committee has several knowledgeable HVAC experts and am waiting for some recommendations for a permanent solution.
- Construction has begun again with Ludlow Construction and MassDOT on Main Street in Gilbertville. Expect delays.
- The Council on Aging are holding office hours once again. 12:30PM at Quabbin Estates and Municipal Building (Town Hall) at 10:00AM. Please come down and check out all of the services they have. Snacks served! Eileen and/or Brenda will be at each location on the last Wednesday of the month for an hour at each place unless otherwise necessary.
- DLS submitted a Financial Policy manual. I will be forwarding as soon as I can go through so I may answer any questions you may have.
- Accountant; Shared services.
- Water Commission: We have received the water meters to upgrade technology and researching surrounding towns for rates, as well as exploring regulations and procedures. Meters have been installed. We need to schedule training with Ti Sales and East National Water.
