New:

- Green Community Grant: Will be starting work soon. Contracts have been signed and total project should take approximately 3 weeks.
- We received \$12,500.00 in DLTA grant funds for assistance from CMRPC in designing and creating interactive and physical maps for our blue and green trails to accentuate our eco-tourism facet of the Master Plan. Survey is closed. Final comments will be forthcoming.
- I will have a draft Complete Street Policy for your review at the next meeting. We can begin Tier 2 once that has been approved and submitted.
- Our CDBG has to be submitted by March 25. We have completed all of the required tasks. We have requested approximately \$50k for design of the park and \$900k for Highland Terrace.
- Our Electric vehicle chargers are now online. Free for now, will be .35 per kW when fully commissioned.
- Special Town Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 21 at 6PM in Town Hall
